Have you ever wanted to create a portrait? Here is your opportunity.

Join us for this one day portrait making experience in Wagga Wagga. Experiment with materials and techniques. This workshop is suitable for senior secondary students as well as beginner, intermediate and advanced adult artists.

Tracey will guide you to achieve your portrait image. **Most materials are supplied.**

You will need to bring your own reference photos printed onto copy paper. Print two images - a ½ and ¾ size of an A4 sheet of paper. Bring two to three different photographic images as you will probably create two portraits on the day. You need to bring a cloth, apron, masking tape, flat white palette (ice cream container lid) and water container (Plastic Ice cream container) and brushes.
